the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the War Shipping Administration attend on board the "MANUEL ARNUS" 7578 tons gross of the United States, on July 8th, 1943 and subsequently whilst afloat at the Todd Galveston Dry Docks, Inc. for the purpose of surveying the vessel and her machinery for re-classification, alterations and damage repairs.

Preliminary examinations were made of the following parts:

- Fore and after peaks and spaces above.
- All holds and bunkers.
- All decks, casings, hatchways, deck houses.
- Shell plating above waterline drill tested.
- Decks and bulkheads drill tested where deemed necessary.

The above examinations and drill tests were made to ascertain the condition and to mark off any necessary wear and tear repairs that may be required for classification.

A specification of wear and tear repairs was withheld pending the receipt of plans of proposed alterations, which may have affected such repairs.

Reclassification and contemplated repairs and renewals have now been cancelled by War Shipping Administration letter dated, Galveston, Texas, August 15, 1944.
