Dear Mr, Coote,


I am obliged for your letter regarding the Certificates in the case of the Steamer "MANUEL ARNUS".

The report of the Machinery is No.1900 and it has probably been sent to Cadiz for completion, as the Machinery was sent out there for fitting on board.. The Cadiz Surveyor would require it in connection with the finishing up of the work, and I trust this is the explanation of its going astray.

I understand that "Certified Copies" of the Boiler Test Certificates will satisfy Messrs Vickers. Now with regard to the signature. There is nothing on the counterfoils to say whether Mr. Redman or Mr. Mayne signed them, but from the letters received book, I find they were sent from London on the 23-12-20, and had been despatched from here on the 22-12-20, so that the date was the 23rd December 1920.
