
Enclosed please find original letter received from the Owners Representatives indicating that, as the special survey of the above named vessel had been carried out, by the surveyors of the Bureau Veritas, they, the Owners have no intention of continuing Lloyd's Register Classification from now onwards.

The managing director of the Company informed me that if he had taken his vessel "JEAN & JACQUES" out of Lloyd's Classification it was not by any means that he disliked the Lloyd's Classification. Their Committee, surveyors, or any one connected with Lloyd's, no: it was simply to please his Paris friends of the Bureau Veritas who had been harcelling him continually to do so.
