It is submitted that the Newport News Surveyor
be informed that in this case he should personally
examine the two boilers which were made in 1903, and
if he finds that the condition of plates stay tubes ~~is~~
in no way deteriorated there will be no necessity for again
testing these boilers by hydraulic pressure, and no note of their
having been made in 1903 will be made in the Register Book.

If upon examination the boilers are found to be in no way deteriorated
and notwithstanding this the owners desire them to be retested, he
may witness the retest and have a new date of test stamped upon
the boiler, but this should only be done at the request of the owners.
In the event of this being done new test certificate will be issued.
