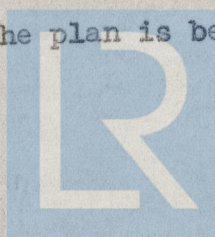

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 22nd instant enclosing a plan (in duplicate) showing hatch web carriers for Messrs. Howaldtswerke's Yard No. 765, and with regard thereto I have to state that the arrangements as shown and amended on this plan will be approved, provided they be carried out to your satisfaction.

With regard to the question of the depths of the webs at Nos. 1 & 3 hatchways in the tween decks, I have to point out that the depths given, viz. 550 and 460 m/m respectively, represent the minimum which could be accepted to comply with the standard of the Rules with mounting angles of sizes proposed. If it is desired, in view of the plates being ordered, to adhere to the depths originally proposed by the Builders, it will be necessary to increase correspondingly the sizes of the mounting angles, or alternatively to fit a rider plate on the lower mountings.
