I am in receipt of your classing letter of the 29th instant in regard to the steamer "WAR BERYL" and in regard thereto beg to state that the thickness of rudder plating should have been 1.10 and regret that this thickness was incorrectly stated on the report.

In regard to the thickness of bulkhead plating the scantlings as stated on the report were as fitted in the vessel.


The bulkheads in this vessel were plated vertically and the scantlings were approved of the thicknesses stated on a plan dated 24. 11. 17. on which alternate thicknesses were given for bulkheads plated vertically and horizontally.
