In the circumstances, I shall be glad if you will be good enough to amend our memorandum form accordingly.

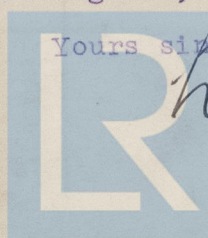
