Re: S.S. "ZEMBRA"

We still have to acknowledge receipt of your favours of the 24th and 26th July 1937, in which you informed us of your communications with Lloyd's Register.

We now can inform you, that the original-certificates of the Deighton-furnaces (with tensile-value), quoted in our letter to Lloyd's Register of the 23rd July, are definitely required by the Bremisches Amt, and we kindly request you to provide same for us.

The documents for the donkey-boiler need not be ordered from Lloyd's, until we have heard, if the letter of Lloyd's Register enclosed with your favour of the 24th, is accepted by the Bremisches Amt or not. These documents thus can remain at Lloyds until we come back on this matter.
