

s.s. "ZEMBRA" - Built 1923.

A representative of Messrs. Stelp & Leighton Ltd., London Agents for Messrs. Fried. Krupp A.G., called at this Office this morning in connexion with the attached letter received from Messrs. Krupp's who, it was subsequently stated by 'phone, are now the Owners of this vessel. (This information was confirmed by Messrs. F.C. Strick & Co., who at present still appear in the Register Book as the registered Owners).

Messrs. Fried Krupp desire to be furnished with certificates relating to the tests of the material used in the construction of this vessel's boilers, also of the material used in the manufacture of the furnaces which were renewed in 1935, and the welded combustion chamber tube plate.

It was explained to the representative of Messrs. Stelp & Leighton that it would take some days to obtain the desired certificates from the Society's Surveyors concerned, and he stated that in view of the urgency they would accept in the meantime the usual letter setting forth details of the Rules in force at the time the material in question was manufactured.

He intimated that he desired the letter to be handed to him, together with a copy for his Firm's records, and that he would forward the letter direct to Messrs. Krupp's and explain the circumstances to them and ascertain whether they still desired to be furnished with certificates.

He also stated that he would ^{also} endeavour to obtain more definite information regarding the enquiry about the donkey boiler and communicate with this Office further in the matter.
