With reference to the Monmouth Shipbuilding Co's No. 375 ship, this vessel was launched on 19th October, 1921, and was completed during the quarter ending 31st March, 1922, the dates of our last visits for Special Survey of hull and machinery being respectively 13th December, 1921, and 10th February, 1922. Since that time the vessel has been on the builders' hands pending sale, and we have ^{now} been requested by the prospective owners to ascertain, if under the above circumstances, the vessel's completion may be dated from the trial trip, which will ^{be} run shortly, and not from six months after date of launch as stated in paragraph 7 of the Society's General Regulations for the Classification of Steel Vessels.
