Mr. Cox forwards a letter from the Owners in which it is stated that owing to the vessel's age it has been decided to discontinue class.

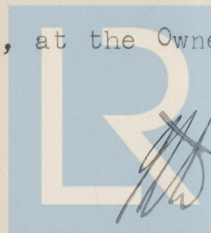
It is submitted the vessel class be withdrawn from the Register Book and Three dots (...) be inserted in lieu, indicating withdrawal of class, at the Owners' request.
