I have to acquaint you that Mr. H. Jasper Cox, the Society's Principal Surveyor for the Far East, has forwarded to this Office a translation of your letter of the 23rd May last respecting the steamer "TOHUKU MARU", from which it is noted that you have decided to class this vessel with the Teikoku Kaiji Kyokai and that you no longer desire to retain her classification in this Society's Register Book.

In the circumstances the Committee, who have today had the case before them, decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and Three Dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
