Messrs. Gutehoffnungshütte A.G. Oberhausen on the 14th and 18th January, 1939, at their works at Sterkrade inspect 1 spare propeller shaft of S. "Ursula Rickmers". The brass liner has been removed and the shaft inspected. It was observed that 6 holes of 5/8" diameter and 1/2" to 3/4" deep had been bored in the shaft for fixing the old liner with brass screws.

The shaft has been turned over and was found to be sound and has been fitted with a new liner.

Results of tests of the material of the liner:

Tensile str. 31,9 Kg.sqmm.

Elongation 20, -% in 4x diameter.
