SECTION 2

This vessel, which until recently had been laid up since 1937, is overdue for various inspections, namely, the Boiler Survey due in May 1937, the Screwshaft Survey in May 1938, and the Second Special Survey No.1 in June 1939. She was examined in drydock at Marseilles in May 1939 for contemplated change of Ownership, and the Surveyors reported that, as a number of side shell plates appeared to be wasted, C and D strakes were drilled throughout and nine plates were recommended to be renewed. The sale, however, did not materialise and the vessel was undocked without any repairs being effected. She was again drydocked in February of this year, but on attendance the Surveyors were informed that the vessel had been sold and that she was no longer classed with this Society.

Every effort has been made to get into communication with the new Owner, but without success and in all the circumstances the Classing Committee, who had the case before them on Friday, 28th ultimo, decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be expunged from the Society's Register Book with a Red Line (6,40), indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
