Dear Sir,

I beg to inform you that the new steamer  
"MENDOCINO", Messrs. Sir J. Laing & Sons' No. 661,  
while fitting out at Sunderland, sustained some small  
damage through grounding.

The damage consisted of three bilge plates on  
Port and Starboard sides scored and 4 lengths of bilge  
keel on Starboard side deflected.

The vessel was placed in dry dock and the bilge  
keel repaired.

In my opinion the scored plates referred to in  
no way affect the efficiency or seaworthiness of the vessel.

The Builders and Owners are desirous that this  
vessel should be classed without restriction.

These particulars are now forwarded for the  
information of the Committee.

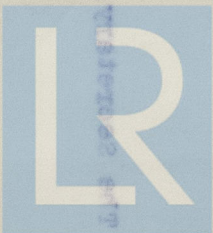
