STEAMER "D.A.GORDON", 2301 tons. No. 1 in R.B.

MOTOR SHIP "FORDONIAN", 2368 tons, No. 431 in R.B.

These vessels are owned by the Canada Steam Ship Lines, Ltd., of Montreal, and hold restricted classes for service on the River St. Lawrence and Great Lakes - the last one being for Canadian Lake service only.

Some correspondence has taken place with reference to the requirements necessary to entitle the steamers to be employed for seagoing purposes, in which service they have recently been engaged ; and the Owners now state that they have withdrawn the vessels from classification in this Society's Register Book, and have transferred them to the classification of the British Corporation. *W.R.*

The Classing Committee had the circumstances before them on Friday, the 18th instant, and decided to withdraw the classes of the steamers from the Register Book, and to insert three dots (. . .) in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of classes at Owners' request.
