I beg respectfully to submit, for the consideration of the Committee, a letter received from The Clyde SB & Eng Co Ltd. shewing the proposed equipment they intend supplying to their S.S. No.278.

The Builders have informed us that their proposal is equivalent to the requirements "For Channel purposes" and it will be observed they propose to omit the 2nd bower anchor, the stream anchor and 60 fathoms of the stud chain cable.

In view of the special class of the vessel, the Builders' proposal is respectfully submitted for the consideration of the Committee.
