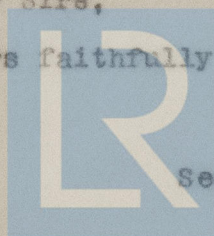
With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of your steamer "AGNES ELLEN" I beg to remind you that the screw shaft of this vessel has not been drawn in for examination by the Society's Surveyors since she was built in December 1908 and as the Society's Rules require this to be done at intervals of not more than two years I shall be obliged if you will kindly let me know for the information of the Committee when and at what port you propose complying with this requirement.

At the same time I think it well to acquaint you that the Special Survey No.1 prescribed by the Society's Rules will become due on this vessel at the end of the present month and I enclose for your information an abstract from the Rules describing the requirements of this survey together with a list of the ports at which Surveyors to this Society are stationed.
