Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 6th instant, respecting the Sr. "AGNES", I have to acquaint you that the case of this vessel received the consideration of the General Committee of the Society yesterday, and that as no arrangements were made by the Owner for the caulking to be submitted for examination before the vessel left your port as required the Committee have given instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line.
