Dear Sir,

S. Reverting to my letter of the 26th ultimo, respecting your SR "AGNES", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have again had the case before them to-day, and in view of the fact that the vessel appears to have left Bristol without the caulking having been submitted to the inspection of the Society's Surveyor the Committee regret that they now have no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Society's Register Book with a red line.

The Committee desire me to add that immediately upon the vessel being submitted for the requisite surveys, and upon receipt of a satisfactory report thereon from the Society's Surveyors, the vessel will be eligible to be recommended to the Committee for the re-instatement of her character.


