Sir,

With reference to the enclosed report No.4973 received from the Society's Surveyor at Falmouth and correspondence respecting the case of the Sr. "AGNES", I have to acquaint you it is understood the vessel is now bound to Bristol and it is considered that the bottom should be recaulked at that port or that she should be placed on a gridiron and the caulking of the bottom tested by you.

The Owner has been requested to make arrangements accordingly and I have therefore to request that you will give the case the necessary attention. I may add that the Owner is also the vessel's Master.

At the same time I have to inform you that the Owner wishes to defer the Half Time Survey until February or March next and I have therefore to request that after you have examined this vessel you will report whether in your opinion the Committee might agree to this proposal.
