I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 3rd November last respecting the classification in the Society's Register Book of the Russian Steamers, "BAIKAL", "DOBRIYA NIKITICH" and KOZAK PIARKOV", from which it is noted that the Port Authorities are unable to maintain the classification of these vessels.
