

In reply to enquiry, Lloyd's Agents at Vladivostok  
forward a letter received from the Administration of the  
Vladivostok Commercial Port, intimating that it is not proposed  
to maintain the classification of the steamers "DOBRINA NIKITICH"  
and "KOZAK PIARKOV" in the Register Book, and that, as the Russian  
Military Authorities have no funds, the same applies to the  
steamer "BAIKAL".

In the circumstances the Classing Committee, who  
had the cases before them on Friday, 23rd ultimo, decided to give  
instructions for the class of each vessel to be withdrawn from the  
Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof,  
indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
