The Second Special Survey No.3 of this vessel became due in September, 1921, but the East London Surveyor now forwards a letter from the Owners, intimating that it has been decided to withdraw the vessel from the Society's Classification.

In the circumstances the Classing Committee, who had the case before them on Tuesday, 7th instant, decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
