P.S. - As regards the present boilers of this vessel, I may say that the annual survey was held at East London in July last, but in view of the condition in which they were found, it was recommended by the Surveyor that the boilers should be again examined before the end of January, 1922 and the vessel's class was allowed to remain subject to this being done. I may further say that the chain cables now on board which are not those reported upon when the 2nd Special Survey No.2 was held in 1919, require to be properly tested if this has not already been done.
