I have been making inquiries about the new boilers which have been on order for some time, but up to the present the authorities here have no information as to their shipment. XXXX

"PERC-DA NHAYA" The repairs to this vessel are proceeding satisfactorily, but I am of opinion that it will take till the middle of September to so far complete the repairs to the bottom plating, as to allow her to come off the slipway. New decks and other above water repairs can be completed when afloat.

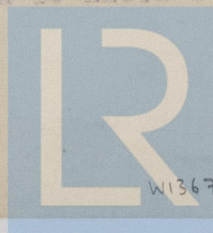
