Dear Mr. Redman,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 21st instant in regard to vessels owned by the French Government, and await the receipt of a further communication from you in regard to the "MARIA DEL CARMEN", "SAN JOSE", "SAN MIGUEL", "SAN RAFAEL", "GUSTITI" and "SEDUISANT", after which I will submit these cases to the consideration of the Committee.

The case of the "FLEURDELYS" will now be stated up and placed before the Committee, but I shall take no action in regard to the "UNKAI MARU No.2", now named "INDOCHINE" until I hear from you: you will remember that I wrote to you about this vessel on the 20th instant.

The cases of the "BRANLEY MOORE" and the "GIJON MUSSEL" will be placed before the Committee next Friday and I will write to you as to the result.

I note that you will write to the Marine Marchande and the Marine in regard to the "DORDOGNE" ex "SILVERLIP".

I take this opportunity to enclose an up-to-date list of German and Austro-Hungarian vessels allocated to France.
