We are in receipt of your letter of the 3rd instant regarding motor ship "WOENS DreCHT" and note that the fees suggested are approved.

Regarding the cargo pump room no lighting is at present fitted but the Superintendent stated he proposes to have the same fitted in accordance with the rules on the vessels returning to this country. As however the original wiring and fittings are still in position, though the leads to the ship's mains have been disconnected, it would perhaps be advisable to attach a special condition to the class reading:-

"electric lighting of cargo pump room not to be used until approved in accordance with the rules".
