I have to acknowledge the receipt of Mr. Edgar's letter of the 18th instant enclosing a plan (in duplicate) of the Oertz rudder proposed to be fitted to the motor tanker "WOENSDRECHT", and the contents have been carefully noted.

In reply thereto I am directed to state that provided the arrangements be carried out as shown and amended on the plan, and to your satisfaction, they will be approved.

I have further to state that the rudder should be caulked and made watertight in accordance with the existing practice of the Committee for double plate rudders.
