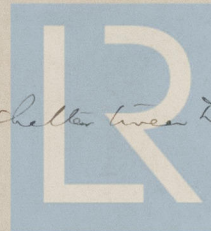
The class of this vessel is subject to a joining shackle being tested and found in order at the first convenient opportunity.
