We are responsible for her condition to the "Brazilian Authorities who hold a survey on the "ARARY" every twelve "months - in every respect the same as other Tugs belonging to this "Company; in consequence we shall not put the "ARARY" through Lloyd's "survey again."

It is submitted the vessel's class be withdrawn from the Register Book, and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
