M I have to return herewith your First Entry Report No. 5462 on the new Steamer "ARARY", and I shall be glad if you will be good enough to complete the same by filling in the length of the vessel, depth "d", proportions, and the weight of the stock of the third anchor, at the same time stating what arrangements have been made for fitting the 6" x 6/20" bulb plate stiffener on the after peak tank bulkhead.

I have also to draw your attention to the fact that the Builders stated on the 9th ultimo that it was not intended to use the fore peak as a tank, and in view of this space having been tested and the capacity forwarded by you, I shall be glad to learn whether it is intended to use this space as a tank, or not.
