Nature of Survey

It is submitted that before this case receives the consideration of the Committee this report should be returned to the Plymouth Surveyor, and he should be requested to complete it by filling in the length of the vessel, depth (d), proportions and the weight of the stock of the 3rd lower anchor.

He should at the same time state what arrangements have been made for fitting the 6 x 6/20ths bulb plate stiffener on the after peak tank bulkhead.


His attention should also be called to the fact that the Builders stated on the 9th January that it was not intended to use the fore peak as a tank, and in view of his having tested this space and forwarded the capacity, he should state clearly whether it is intended to use this as a tank or not.
