The First Special Survey No. 1 became due on
this Motor Vessel in May 1917, and has been partly held.

The Genoa Surveyors stated in October last that
the vessel was laid up, and that nothing further had been
done in regard to the completion of the Special Survey
on account of the strike.

The same Surveyors now state that they are informed
by the Owners that the vessel is being altered to make her
suitable for the coasting trade, and that her classification
with this Society will no longer be required.

The case received the consideration of the
Classing Committee on Tuesday, the 16th instant, when it
was decided to withdraw the vessel's class from the
Register Book, and insert three dots (...) in lieu,
indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
