The screw shaft of this fishing vessel became due for survey  
in July last.

No reply was received from the Owners to the usual  
notices.

In reply to a further notice sent to the Owners on the 19th  
ultimo they now write that the vessel only calls at the ports  
on the Algarve coast between Guarteira and Vila Real de Santo  
Antonio, where the survey cannot be carried out as there are  
no Surveyors to the Society stationed in the district. They  
will, however, give instructions for the survey to be held  
should the steamer proceed at any time to a port where a Surveyor  
is stationed.

In the circumstances, however, the Classing Committee  
decided on the 16th instant to withdraw the vessel's class from  
the Register Book and to insert three dots (...) in lieu thereof  
indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
