

W. Sch. "Bangkok"

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This vessel was built in 1919 & fitted with a donkey boiler made at Bangkok in December 1907. The boiler was examined by the Bangkok Surveyor in March 1919 & found to be in good working order.

A plan of this boiler has now been received from the Surveyor at Bangkok from which it appears that the boiler was made for a working pressure of 120 lbs. per square inch. The plan has now been compared with the Rules & complies with them for a working pressure of 105 pounds per square inch.

It is submitted that this vessel is eligible for THE RECORD. DBS 3/19 105 lb.

Subject to the D.B. being surveyed annually, the next survey was due in 3. 20.

It is submitted the Bangkok Surveyor be informed that this boiler can only be approved for a working pressure of 105 pounds & the safety valves may be adjusted to 100 pounds per sq. inch.
