
Gentlemen,

With reference to your letter of the 26th. inst., enclosing one from Messrs J.P. Rennoldson & Sons, respecting the Nominal Horse Power of the Pad.S. "BARTON" upon which you have charged the fees for survey during construction of this vessel's machinery, as per your first entry report No. 46001, and to which they have taken exception, I have to acquaint you in regard thereto that in this instance the Engine Builders horse power of the engines will be accepted, but at the same time I have to state that the horse power of the boilers must also be taken into consideration, and the mean of the two powers may be considered as the total Nominal Horse Power, viz-66, which will make the fee for special survey £9.18.0.

An amended account may therefore be rendered accordingly.
