The S.S.No.1 became due in May 1908, and the year of  
race expired at the end of May last.

The vessel, which was originally owned by the London  
County Council, was recently sold to the Royal Servian Priviledged  
S.S.Co., of Belgrade, who stated in reply to enquiry that all  
surveys were held by the State Commission.

The case received the consideration of the Classing  
Committee on the 17th instant, when it was decided to give  
instructions for the vessel's class to be withdrawn from the  
Register Book, and to insert three dots (...) in lieu thereof,  
indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
