Nature of Survey

This vessel was built under survey and classed A.1. for Government Service.

The Plymouth Surveyor reported in December last that some minor alterations had been carried out and the vessel was proceeding to Bombay, where approved alterations were to be carried out and the survey completed, with a view to the vessel being classed A.1. "Coasting Bombay and Goa."

The Bombay Surveyor now forwards a letter from the Owners in which it is stated that they do not intend to keep the steamer in class.

It is submitted the class of the vessel be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at the Owners' request.
