This vessel was originally owned by the London County Council who gave the usual undertaking in such cases.

Mr. Parson, who has bought the vessel, now states that she will be retained in the Passenger traffic and he is of the opinion that it will not be necessary to continue the Society's class, as the Board of Trade will do all the work required. He wishes, however, to discuss the matter with the Society's Surveyor at Plymouth before actually coming ~~to~~ to a decision. The Owner added that he had a great rush to get the Passenger certificate and he intended the vessel to commence running on the 13th instant. It is submitted action be deferred for the present to the Plymouth Surveyor communicated with.

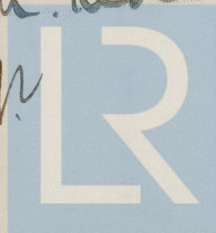
