This is to Certify that

the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Owners' Representative examine on the 10th November, 1941 and subsequent dates the port and starboard main boilers of the steamer "ALPHACCA", 5759 tons gross of Rotterdam, during and on completion of repairs thereto and subsequently did further examine the said boilers under a hydraulic pressure of 150 lbs. per square inch and did find the condition of both boilers good and efficient.

A report has been transmitted to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London stating that all recommendations made by me in connection therewith have been carried out to my satisfaction and that I have recommended that the record of B.C.12,41 be made in the Register Book when the centre boiler and the mountings of all three boilers are examined and the safety valves of the three boilers are adjusted under steam.

REPAIRS. All plain tubes in port and starboard boilers removed together with air preheater tubes of the starboard boiler. Additional minor repairs effected and caulking of seams and rivets overhauled as necessary.
