With reference to your letter of the 8th instant
regarding the S.S. "ASSIOUT" I beg to confirm my telegram as follows:-
"The machinery survey now completed turbine pads only arrived
this morning" Register. Liverpool.

I may state that since the receipt of your letter of the
last time we have been in touch with the Owners' Superintendent
regarding the matter. The pump on port turbine has been made good,
and he promised to advise me when the spare set of pads arrived.
He informs me that they have been mislaid on rail from Birmingham,
and another set were despatched per passenger train and arrived at
Liverpool ahead this morning. It is expected that the vessel will sail
for this port on Saturday next.

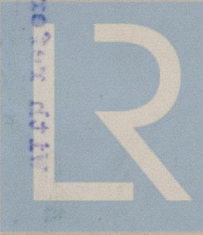
