



Sirs,
With reference to the S.S. "ASSIOUT" now completing
repairs to the propeller here, I beg to confirm the recommend-
ations made verbally to Mr. Inrie, that to complete the survey on
the vessel's machinery, a set of spare pads for the main thrust
(Michell Patent) be placed on board, and the oil lubricating
the Port Turbine be repaired or renewed.

It is understood that on arrival of the vessel at Liverpool
repairs matters will receive attention, and our Liverpool Surveyors
have been requested to call on board, and Report to our London
Office accordingly.
