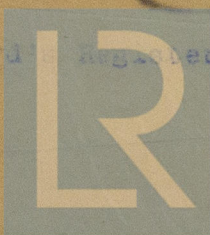
The wheel shaft and wheel, pinions, thrust shaft & Mitchell
