Sir,

I beg to forward herewith my report n^o. 4154 on the turbine machinery made by the British Westinghouse Co. of Manchester and intended to be fitted in the vessel n^o. 70? building by the North of Ireland S.S. Co.

As the double reduction gear was made by the Power Plant Co. of West Drayton probably the London Surveyor who had the matter in hand will fill in the particulars on my report.

The fee, according to Scale, for the turbine machinery amounts to £45-6-0 + £3-0-0 = £48-6-0 allowing 6831 sq. feet of heating surface, forced draft and 180 lbs. press. on boilers. - N.H.P. 506.
£48-6-0 less 25% for boilers or £12-1-6 = £36-4-6

Chargeable

Chargeable for the turbine machinery
And gear and fitting same on board.

I shall be glad to know how
this amount is to be allocated, what
proportion to the London Office for survey
of gear and to Belfast Office for
installing on board (the latter I think is
25% of the total £48.6.0), probably it
would be better for this ~~London~~ office
to render the amount of the fees to
the B. Westinghouse Co. and credit
each port with their proportion
plus travelling expenses if any.
