AMATLAN.—Mexico City, Sept. 7.—It is officially announced that the Mexican tank steamer Amatlan was torpedoed on Sept. 4 by a U-boat, 70 miles off Tampico. Ten members of the crew are missing and 34 others injured.—Reuter.

Mexico City, Sept. 7.—The Mexican Government announced to-day the torpedoing of the Mexican tank steamer Amatlan on the night of Sept. 4, 60 miles from Tampico. This is the sixth Mexican vessel sunk by submarine since May 13.—Exchange Telegraph Company.
