after the meeting, he will write you on the matter.

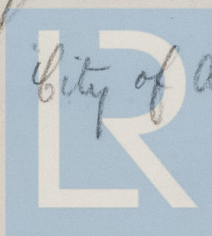
We are also in receipt of your letter of the 7th
