I beg to call your attention to the


following facts:-

I have the s.s. "Coronel" in my hands for sale, and I  
 that she was built in 1910-8 months. Her first No.1 would  
 be due in August 1914. In the register for 1912/13, her  
 class is entered correctly but in the 1913/14 register I find  
 class expunged with a red line dated January 1914, indicating  
 non-compliance with the rules.

In the 1914/15 register which I have this day examined at  
 the Liverpool Branch, I find her class re-instated 100 A1 Para, 3-14  
 3-14.

This irregularity is prejudicing considerably her chances  
 of sale as prospective buyers refer to the 1913/14 register.  
 I hold the Hull and Machinery Certificates for her Special  
 Certificate granted by S. Hailton Jepps, and I will be greatly obliged  
 if you will send me for an explanation which I can put forward to prospective  
 buyers.
