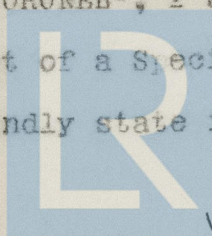
Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 16th instant and to thank you for your proposal to call at this Office in connexion with the surveys held by us at Para. It is not considered necessary, however, to trouble you to proceed to London for this purpose.

The cases in which there are matters still outstanding are two in number; the hopper barge "DOCTOR SABBOLA" and the steamer "CORONEL". In the former case your report on the Special Survey No.2 of the vessel does not appear clear on one or two matters, and I shall feel much obliged if you will kindly let me know whether the engine and boiler spaces and tanks were examined by you. If possible, I shall also be glad if you will forward the marks in the anchors and chains and state when these were placed on board.

As regards the steamer "CORONEL", I send herewith for your information a sample report of a Special Survey No.1, and shall be obliged if you will kindly state in detail on
