Gentlemen,

I have to inform you that the Steel S.S. No. 524 recently built by Messrs. Otto & Zonen at Krimpen a/d Ysel has been towed to Yarmouth at which port it is stated she will be fitted with her machinery.

To complete the survey on the hull, the engine and boiler casing tops require to be riveted and the casing stiffeners to be completed, and the strong beams and pillars between the engine and boiler space to be riveted.

In these circumstances I shall be glad if you will be so good as to give the case the necessary attention and on completion of the survey forward a report on form 8 in the usual manner with a view to the classification of the vessel.
